Plaza Amador's Alberto Quintero (38 years, 230 days) became the oldest player to provide an assist in the last two editions of the Concacaf Central American Cup.

Plaza Amador's Alberto Quintero assisted Julio Rodríguez for their second goal tonight, making it the second time in the 2026 Concacaf Central American Cup that both the assist provider and goalscorer came off the bench, after Alberto Saldaña and Erick Rodríguez for UMECIT against Saprissa.

Firpo's Mauricio Cerritos' goal at 93:20 is the latest goal scored so far in the current Concacaf Central American Cup.

Plaza Amador have won their third home match in the Concacaf Central American Cup, with all three victories coming in the group stage. This win ends a run of two consecutive home defeats in the competition, one in the quarter-finals and one in the play-offs.

Firpo's Mauro González created four chances against Plaza Amador after coming on as a substitute, the joint-most by a substitute in this Concacaf Central American Cup, alongside LD Alajuelense's Celso Borges against Xelajú.

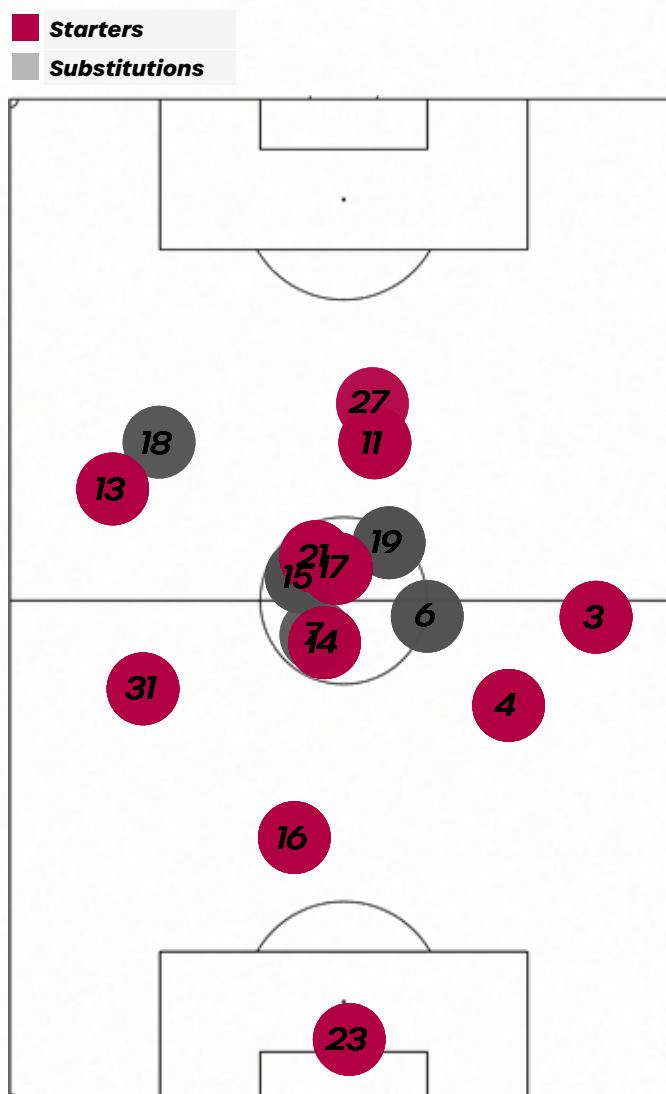

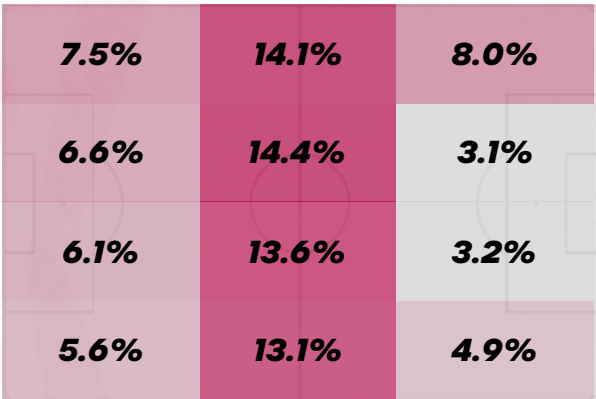

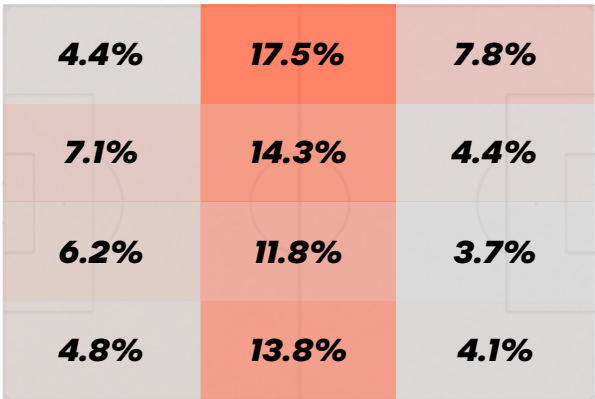

ATTACKING SEQUENCES INVOLVEMENTS

Sequences are a football metric that quantifies the plays within a team's ball possession.

It begins when a player performs a controlled action with the ball, such as a pass or dribble, and ends at the end of that play, either with a defensive action by the opposing team, a break in play, or a shot.

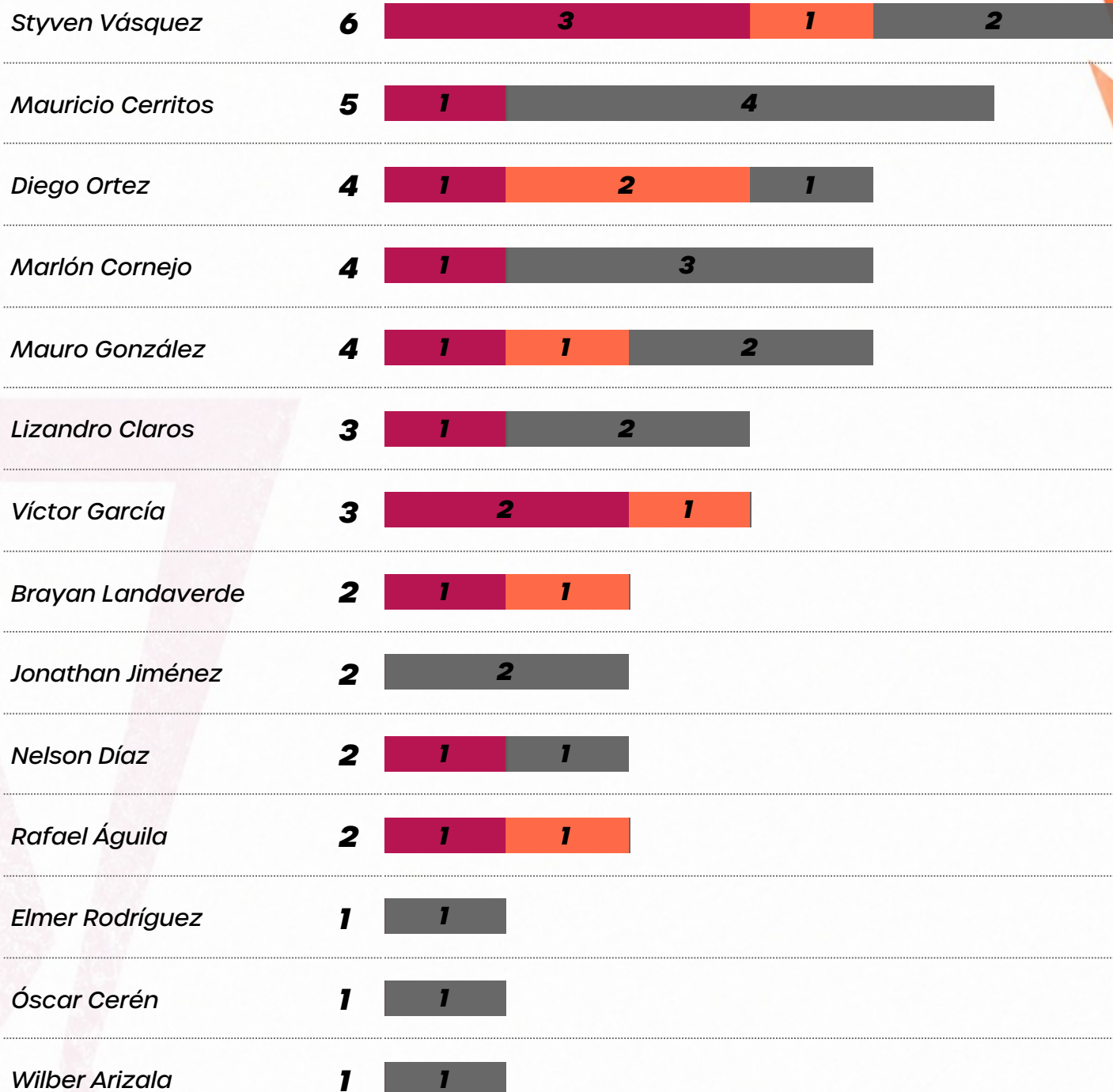
During a sequence, the participation of each player who performs an action with the ball, whether it is a pass, a dribble or a shot, is recorded. If the sequence culminates in a shot, the player is credited with participating in a shot ending sequence.

This participation may be the shot itself, the pass that led to the shot (chance created) or a previous touch in the build ..

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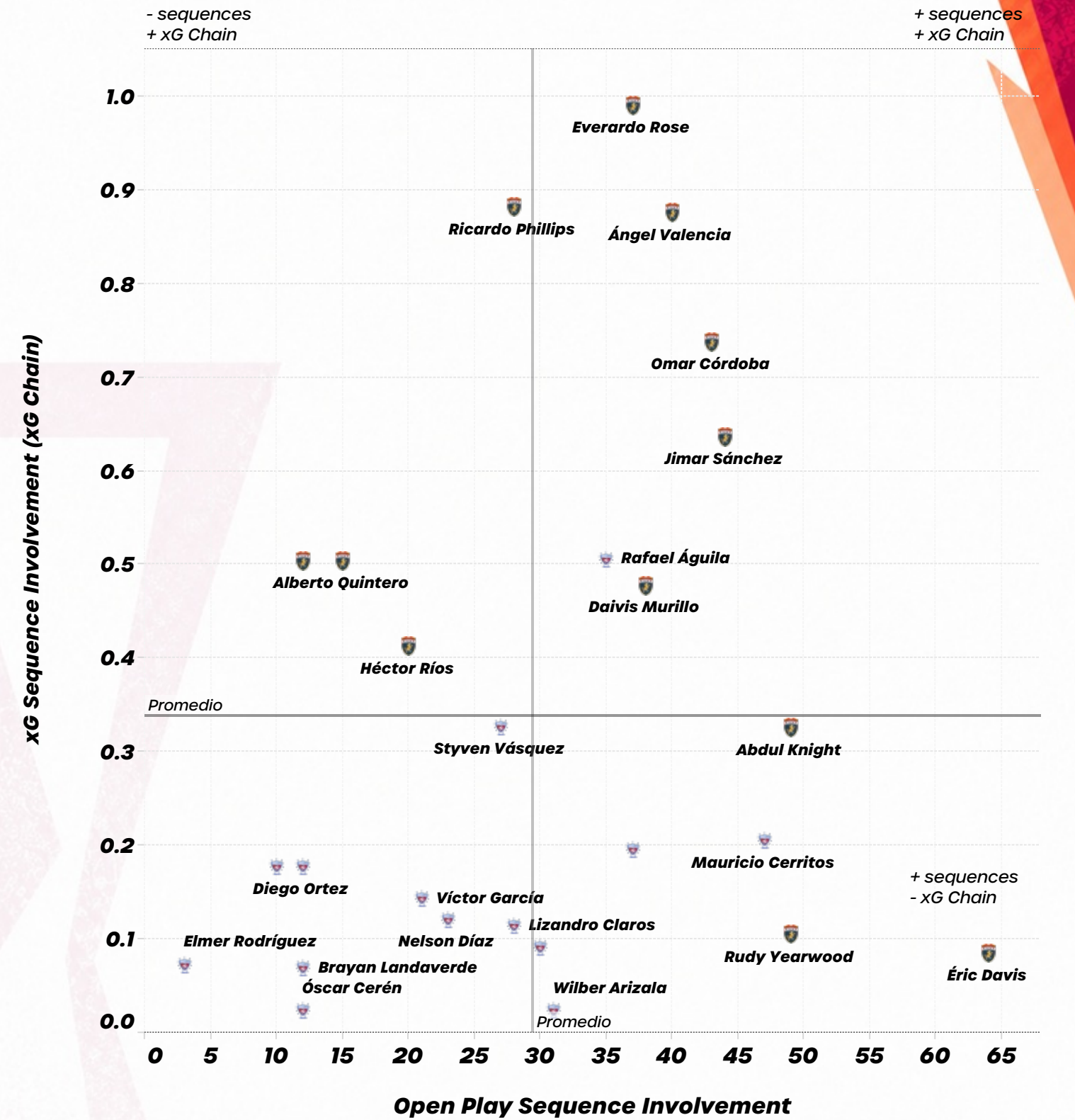

xG Sequence Involvement (xG Chain) The total xG value of unique open play shot or goal ending sequences that a player was involved in.
