- FC Motagua extended its unbeaten record at home in the Concacaf Central American Cup group stages, with six wins and two draws from eight matches. However, the two draws happened precisely in the two encounters with CS Cartaginés.
- This is the first time CS Cartaginés avoided defeat playing away from home in a Concacaf Central American Cup group stage (D2), after losing one away game in its two previous campaigns (W1 L1 in 2023, D1 L1 in 2025).
- CS Cartaginés' José González scored his third career goal in the Concacaf Central American Cup and the second against FC Motagua. In 2024, he had already scored against Motagua in the quarter finals for CS Herediano.
- FC Motagua generated 1.66 expected goals against CS Cartaginés, surpassing 1.5 xG in each of its three matches in the 2026 Concacaf Central American Cup. The Honduran side owns the second highest tally of expected goals in the competition so far (6.72 xG, behind only Plaza Amador's 7.53 xG).
- FC Motagua recorded 36 touches in the opposition box against CS Cartaginés, the second highest tally of any team in a 2026 Concacaf Central American Cup match. The highest also belongs to Motagua (43 vs Verdes FC).

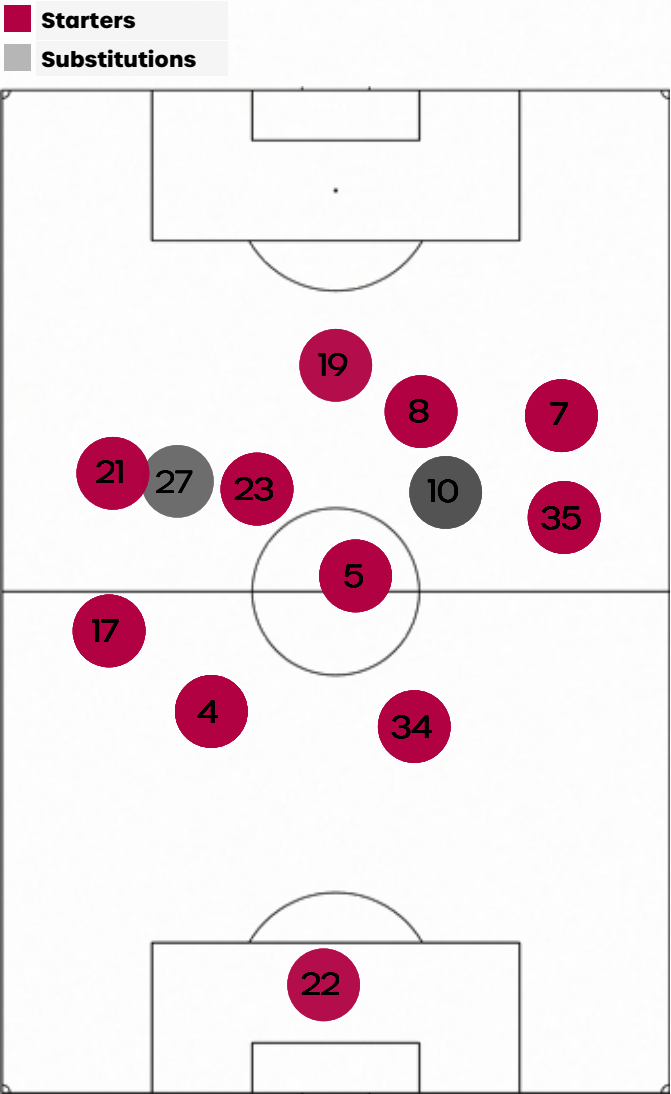

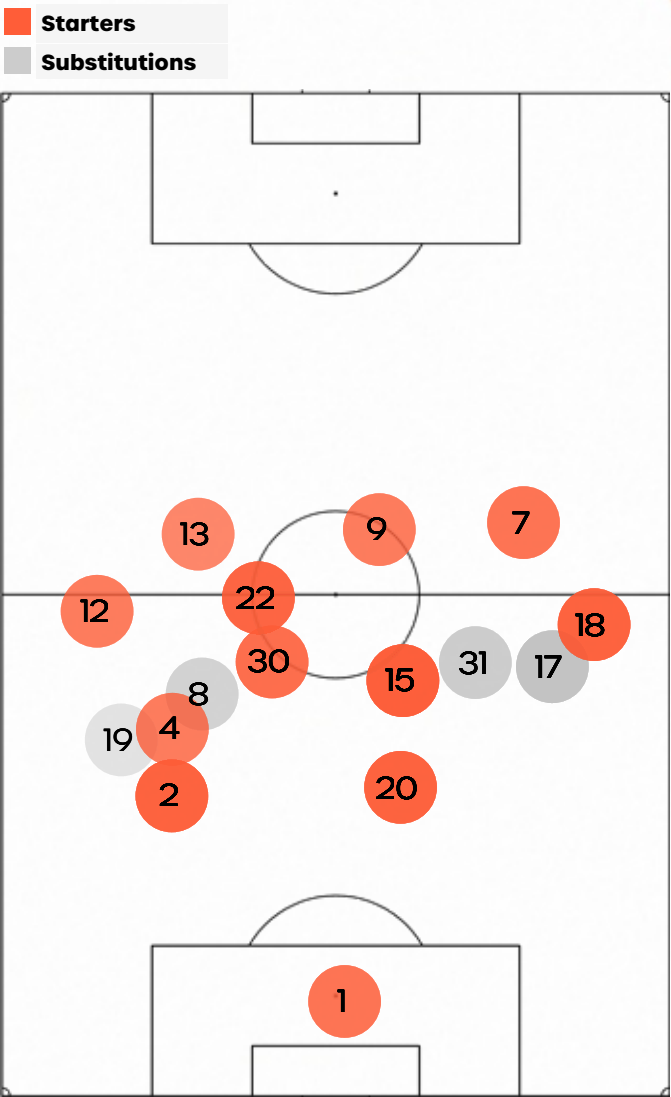
AVERAGE POSITIONS WITH THE BALL



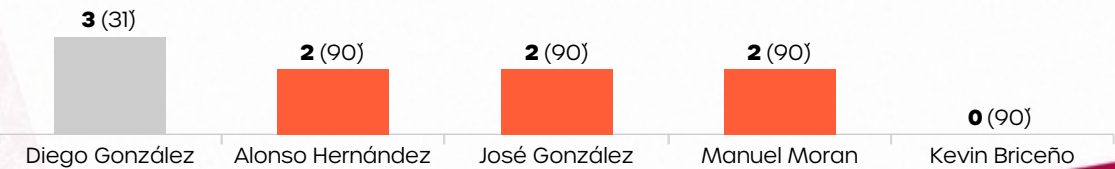

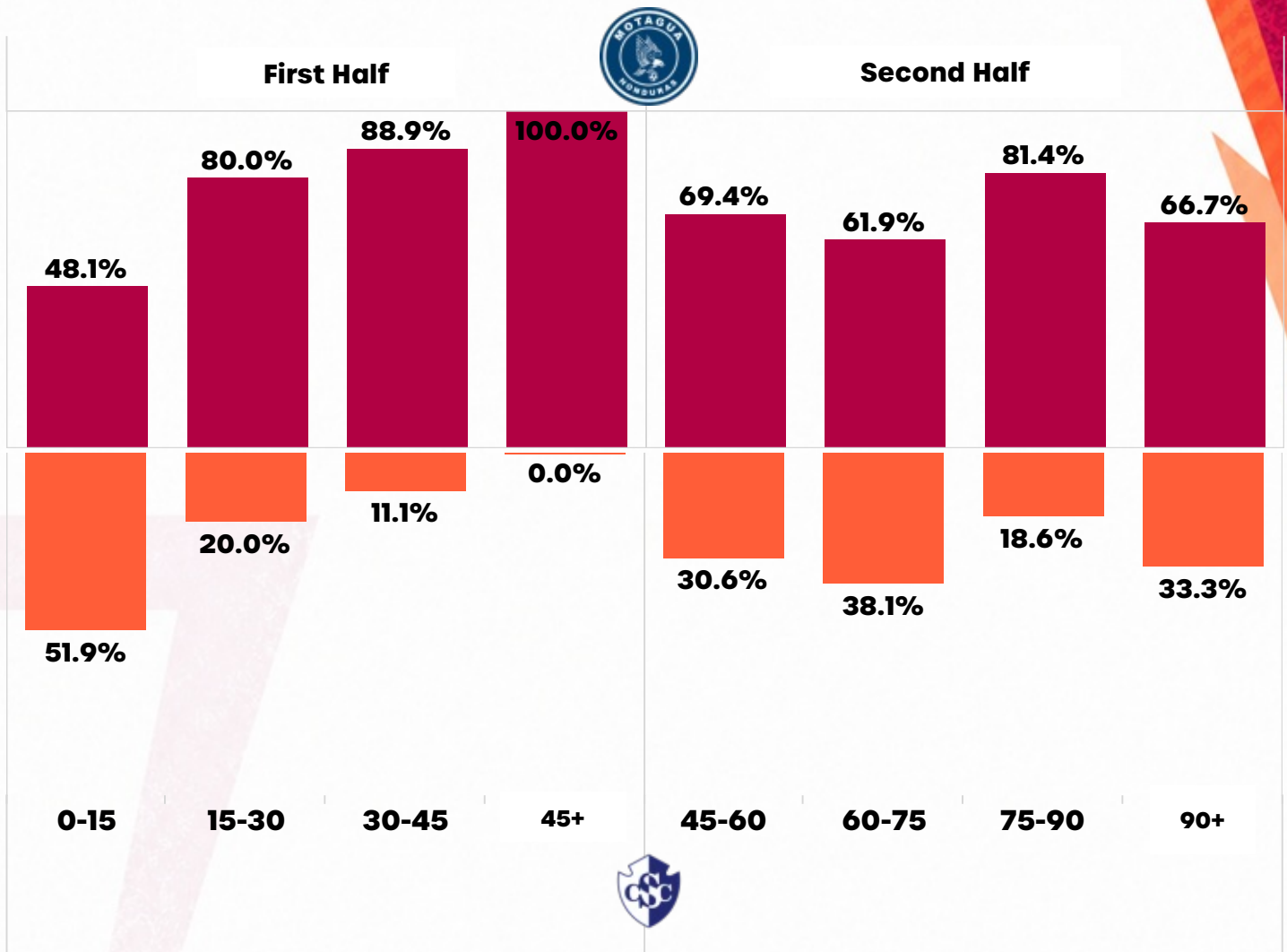

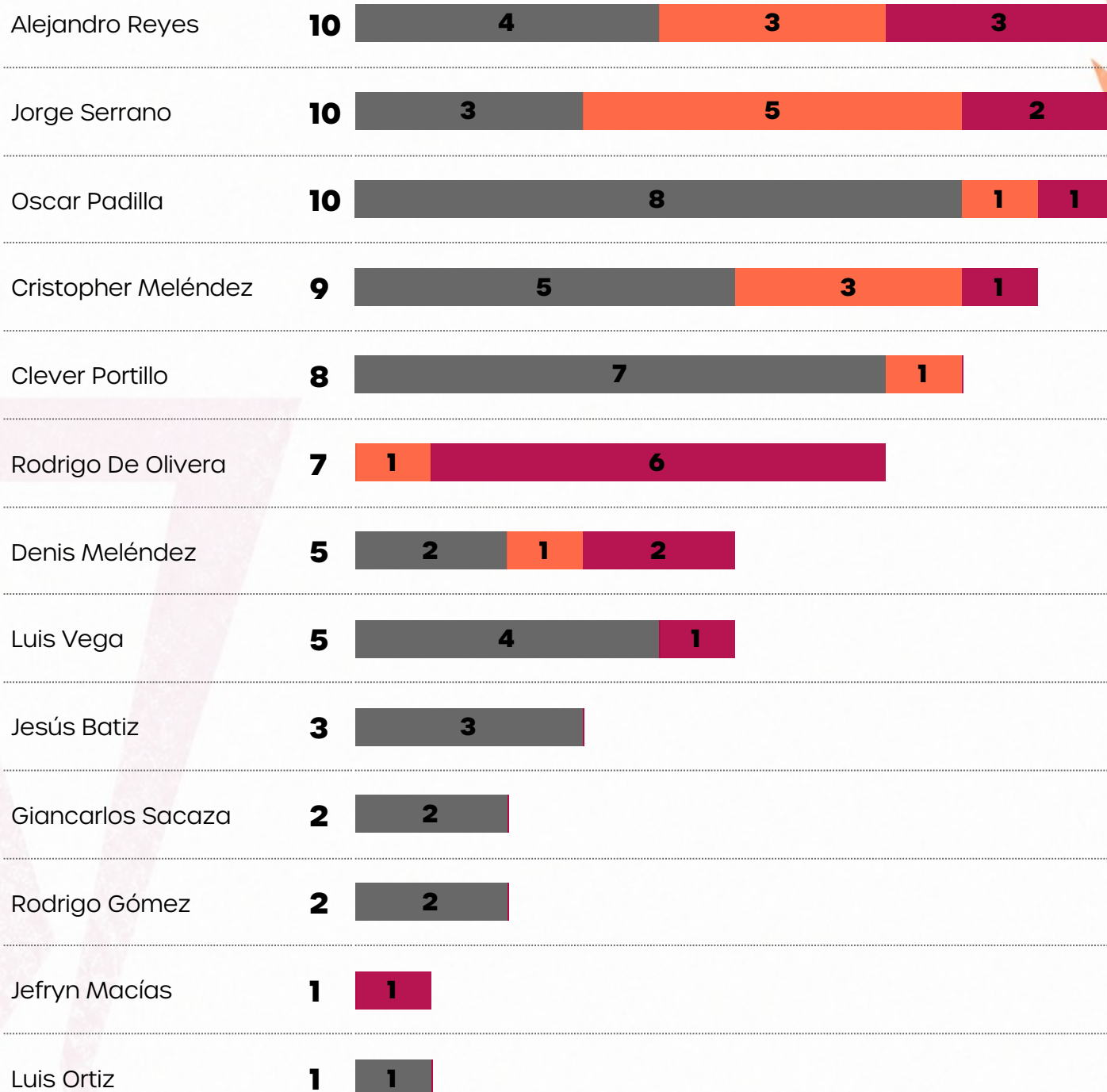
The heat maps show **defensive actions** (clearances, recoveries, interceptions and tackles) by zones.

Sequences are a football metric that quantifies the plays within a team's ball possession.

It begins when a player performs a controlled action with the ball, such as a pass or dribble, and ends at the end of that play, either with a defensive action by the opposing team, a break in play, or a shot.

During a sequence, the participation of each player who performs an action with the ball, whether it is a pass, a dribble or a shot, is recorded. If the sequence culminates in a shot, the player is credited with participating in a shot ending sequence.

This participation may be the shot itself, the pass that led to the shot (chance created) or a previous touch in the build up ..

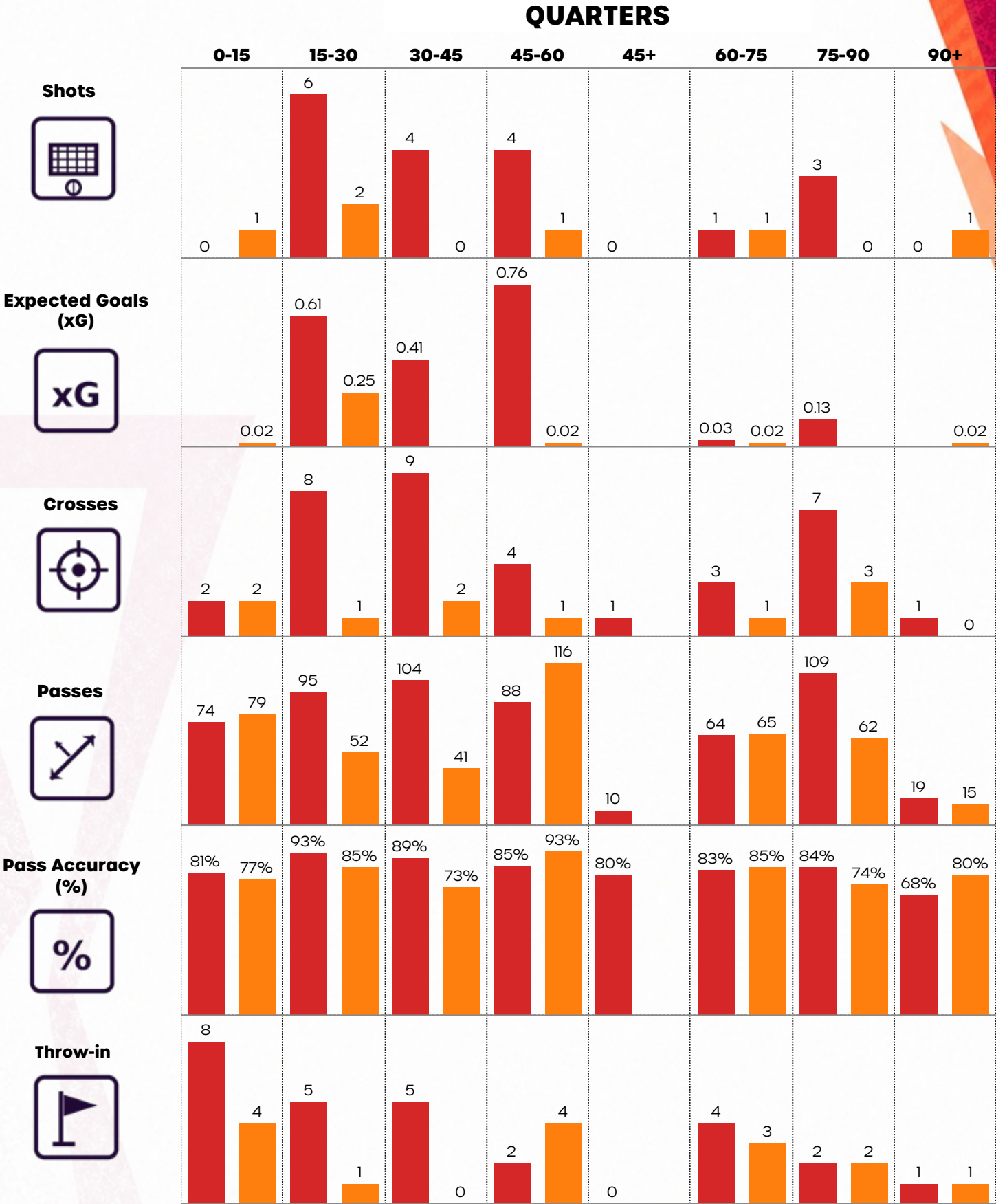
