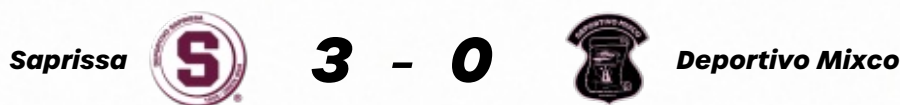

- Saprissa's Gerson Torres is only the second player to score and assist in a single Concacaf Central American Cup match in the last two editions of the competition, alongside Orlando Sinclair against Verdes FC.
- This is the fifth time Saprissa have won by three or more goals in a Concacaf Central American Cup match, with the previous four all coming at home. This is the first time they have recorded a 3-0 victory in the competition.
- Saprissa have not lost in 11 of their 12 home matches in the Concacaf Central American Cup (D1), avoiding defeat in their most recent five (W4 D1).
- Saprissa's Kendall Waston has one goal and one assist in this Concacaf Central American Cup, scoring today against Deportivo Mixco. He had no direct goal involvements in the 2025 edition of the tournament.
- Deportivo Mixco's Nicolás Martínez attempted four of his team's eight shots in this Concacaf Central American Cup match, accumulating 1.22 expected goals (xG), just 0.10 less than the rest of his teammates combined against Saprissa.

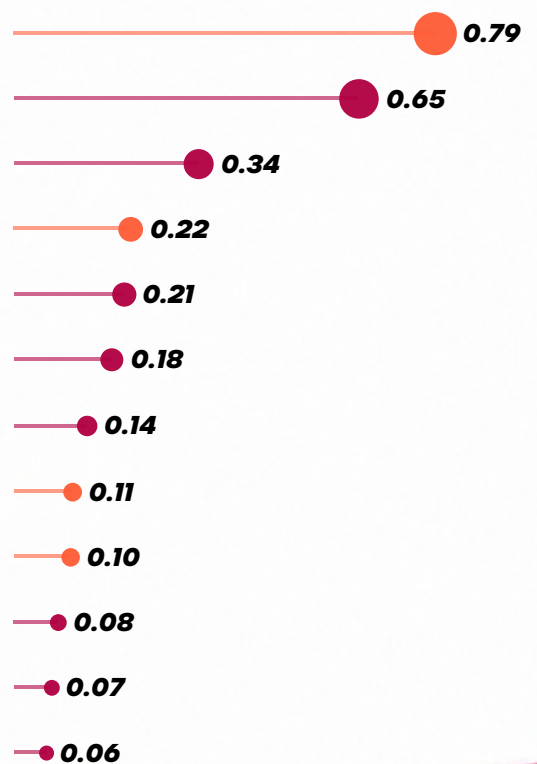

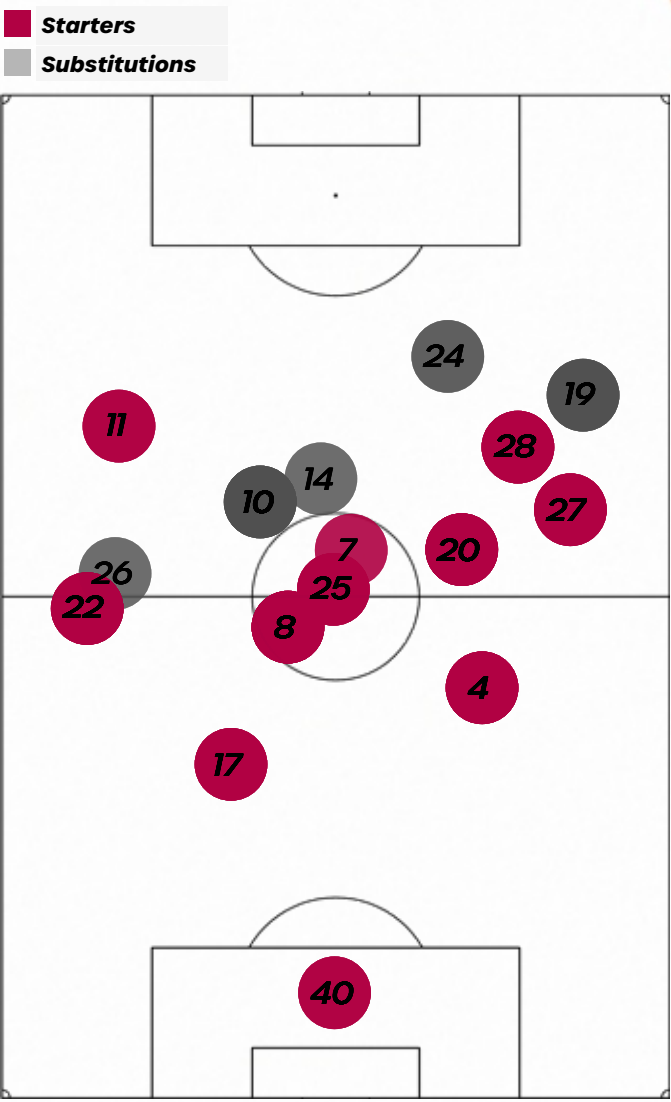

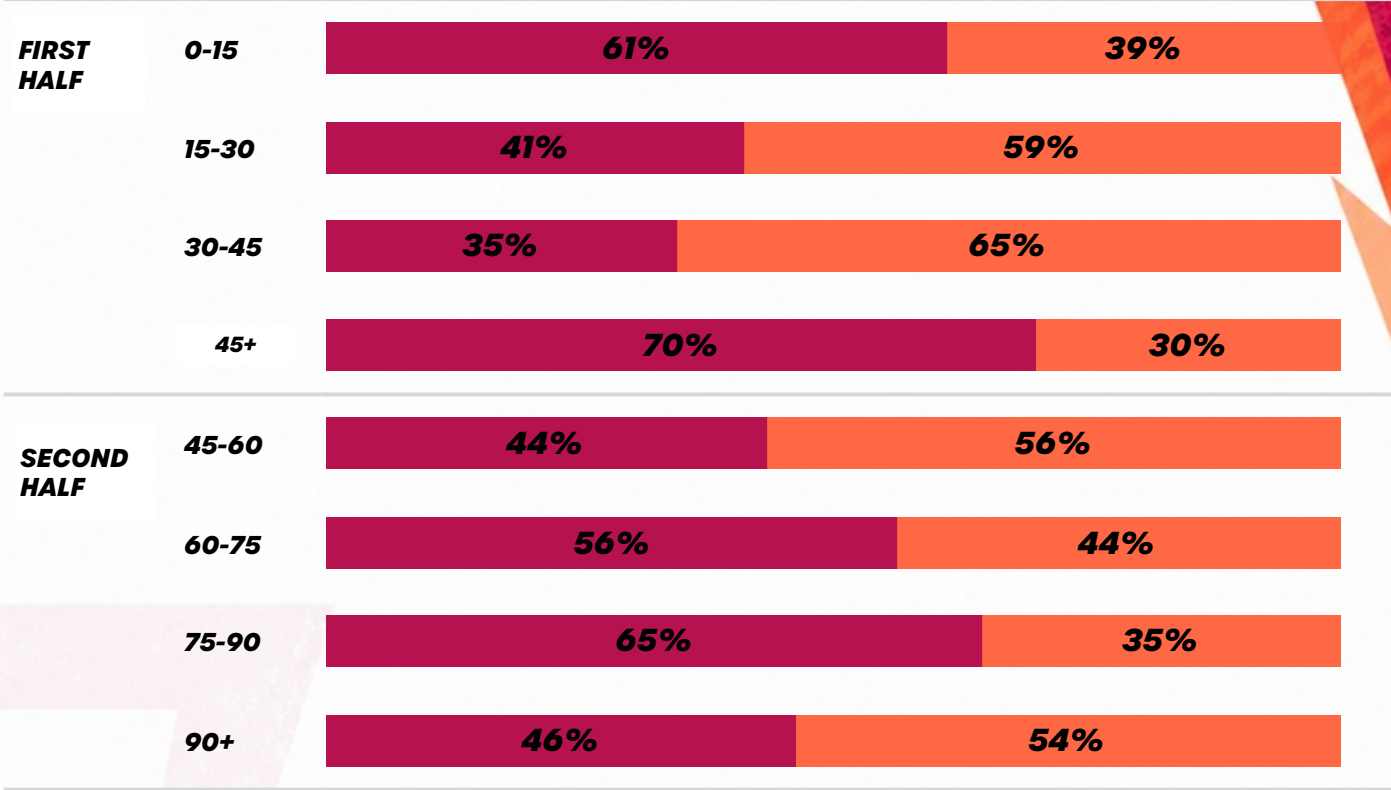

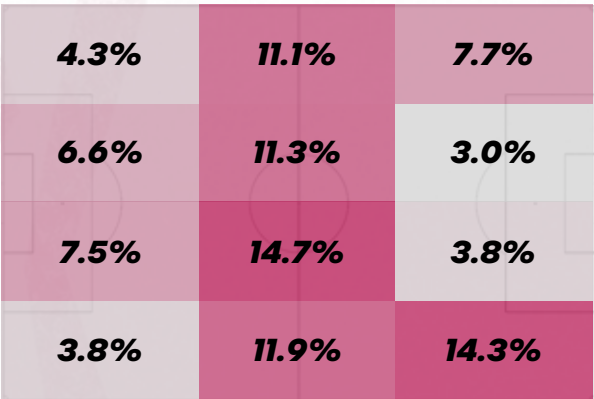

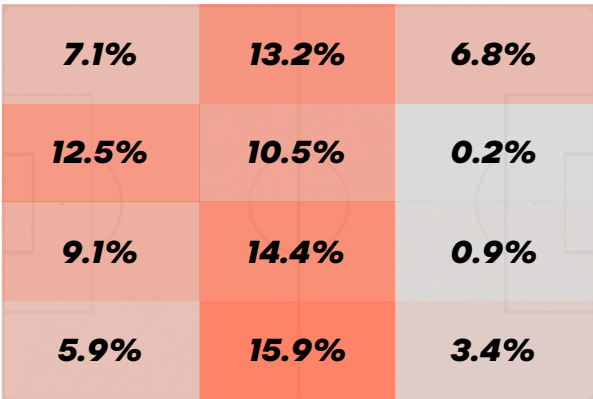

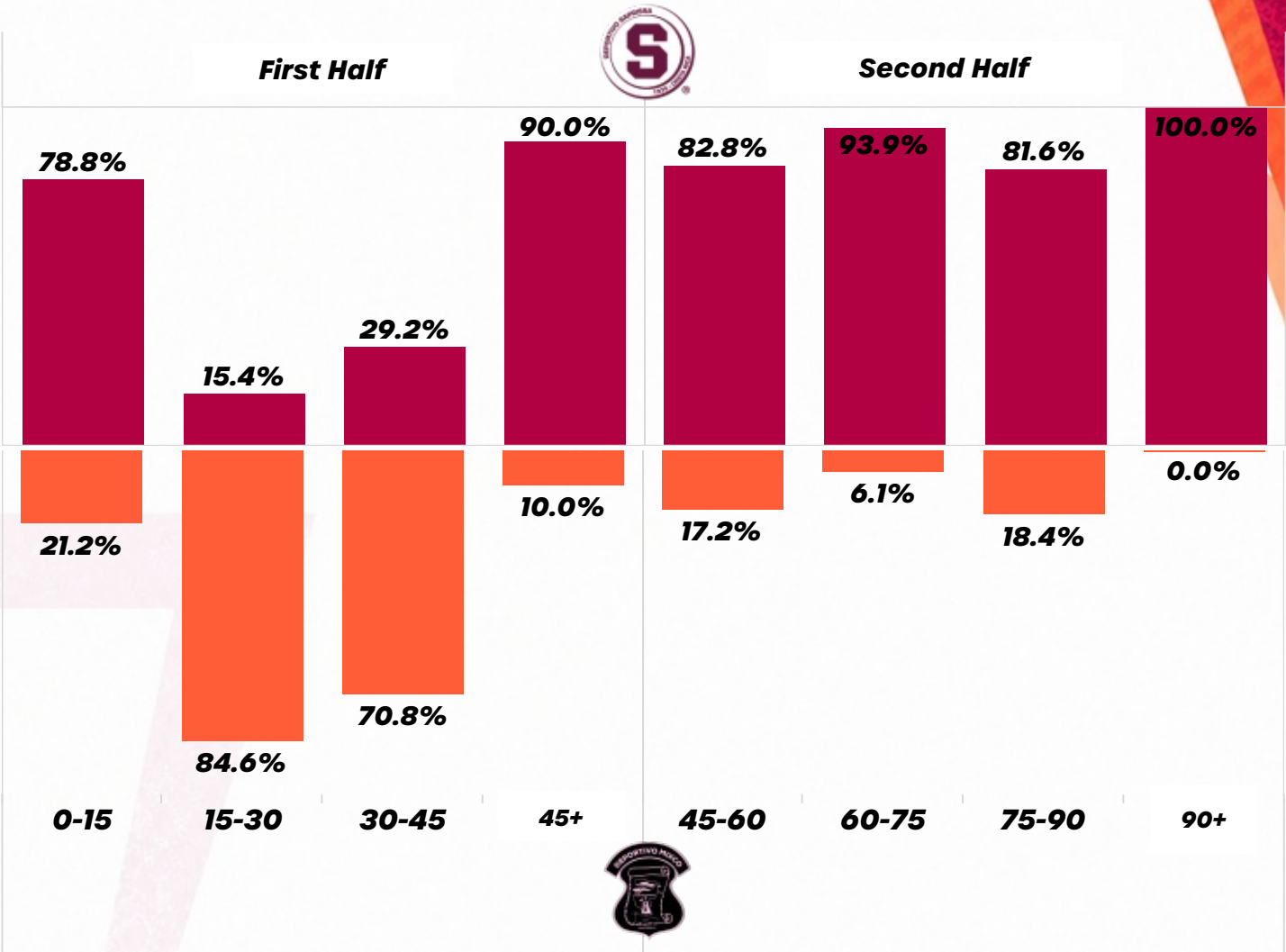

ATTACKING SEQUENCES INVOLVEMENTS



■ Shot
■ Chance Created
■ Build Up to Shot



Sequences are a football metric that quantifies the plays within a team's ball possession.

It begins when a player performs a controlled action with the ball, such as a pass or dribble, and ends at the end of that play, either with a defensive action by the opposing team, a break in play, or a shot.

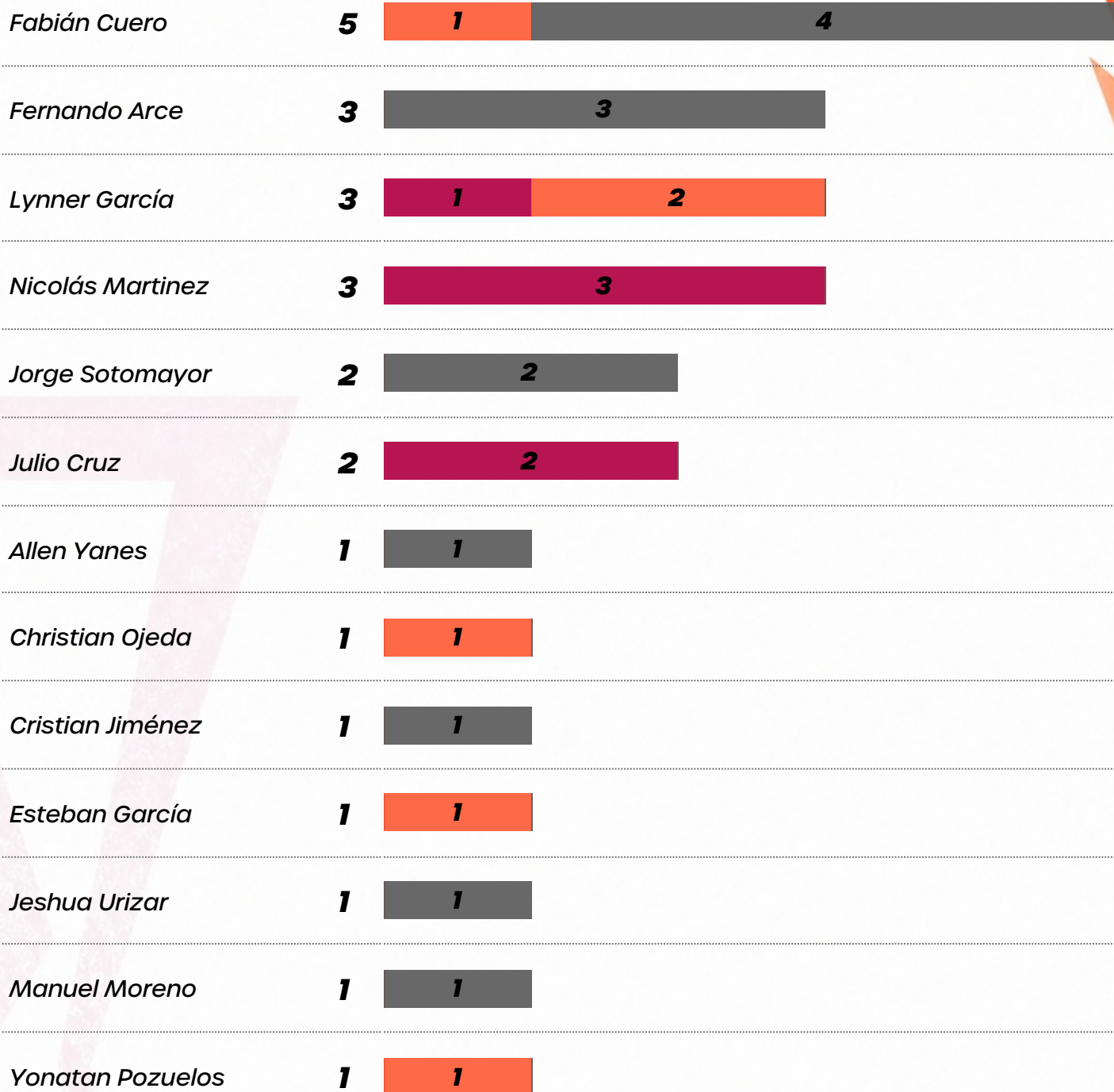
During a sequence, the participation of each player who performs an action with the ball, whether it is a pass, a dribble or a shot, is recorded. If the sequence culminates in a shot, the player is credited with participating in a shot ending sequence.

This participation may be the shot itself, the pass that led to the shot (chance created) or a previous touch in the build ..

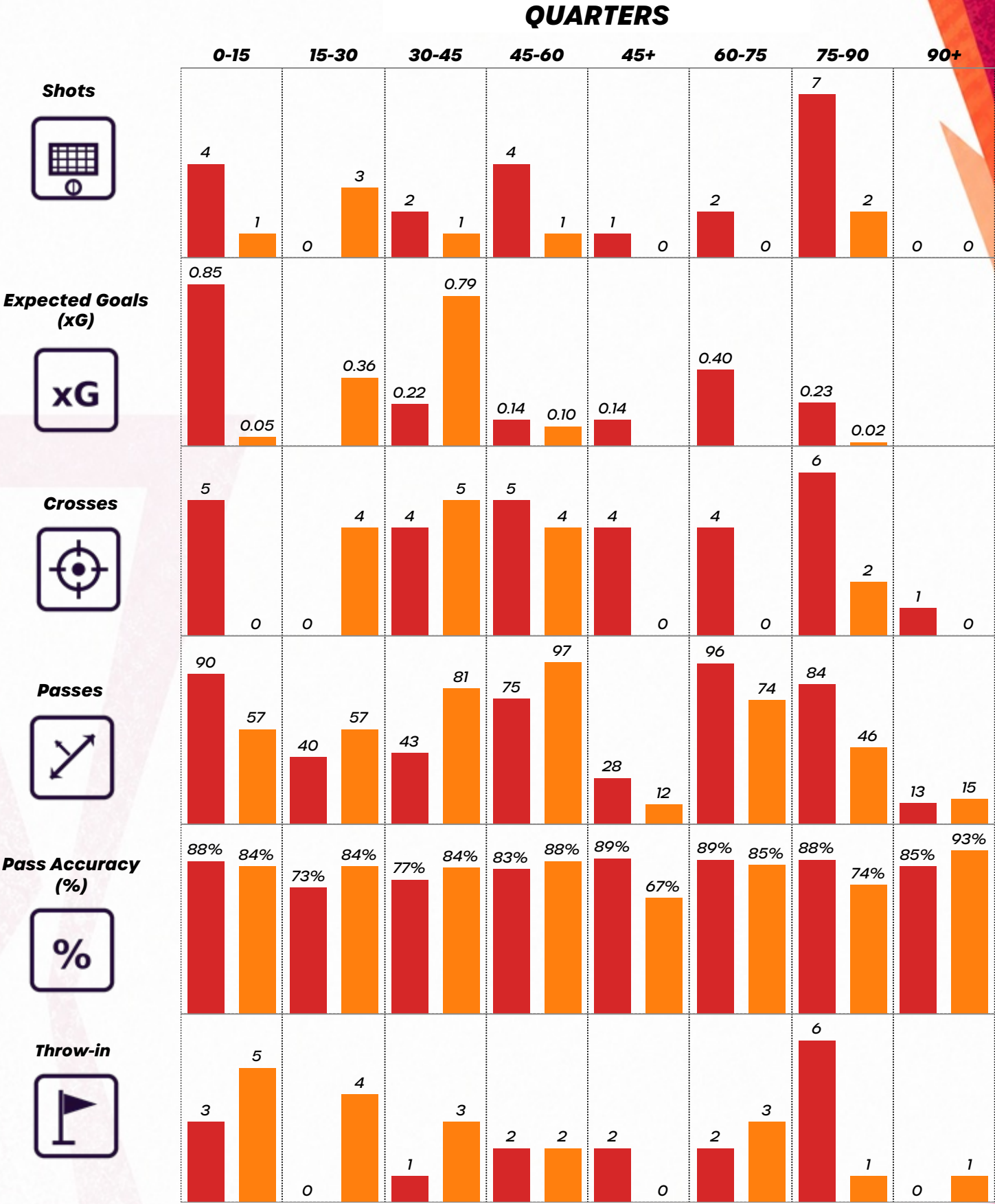
